If a match is All Square after the completion of 18 holes, play shall continue in sudden death format until one player secures the advantage.

In a **handicap match** that extends into extra holes, **shots will be given/taken on holes in the same manner as when played the first time.**

MATCH PLAY INDEX:

B GRADE, JUNIORS and **MASTERS** shall use the Match Play Index as shown on the Twin Waters Golf Club scorecard.

NOTE for LOST BALL and OUT OF BOUNDS:

The alternative procedure to stroke and distance for Lost Ball or Ball Out of Bounds **DOES NOT APPLY.**

LOCAL RULES:

The following Local Rules supersede those shown on the noticeboard and scorecard.

1. **REFEREES** - Rule 20.1b(1)
 The Match Committee named on the Team Sheets are Referees and are deemed to be assigned to each match for the entire round. Referees may intercede for any breach of the Rules they observe.
2. **PACE OF PLAY**
 - a. Satisfactory pace of play is defined as: **2 hours for nine holes, and 4 hours for 18 holes.**
 - b. Referees will monitor pace of play and decide whether a group that is "out of position" should be timed. If a decision is made to time the players, each player in the group will be subject to individual timing and a referee will advise each player that they are "out of position" and they are being timed.
 - c. The maximum time allocated per stroke is:
 - i. Generally – 40 seconds.
 - ii. First player to play a tee shot – 50 seconds.
 - d. Timing ceases when a group is back in position and players will be advised accordingly.
 - e. **Penalty for Breach of Pace of Play Local Rule:**
 - i. Penalty for first breach: **One-stroke penalty.**
 - ii. Penalty for second breach: **Loss of Hole.**
 - iii. Penalty for third breach: **Disqualification.**
3. **MOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS (RULE 15)**
 Temporary cart direction signs, hoops and ropes/posts are movable obstructions and, if moved, must be replaced.
4. **ABNORMAL COURSE CONDITIONS (RULE 16)**
 In bunkers: If the ball is in a Kangaroo Paw Print, Temporary Water or Washout it may be treated as an abnormal course condition and Rule 16.1c applies.

Penalty for breach of Local Rule: Loss of Hole.
